IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW GOVERNMENT TRANSPORT POLICY IN STATE CORPORATIONS

On 15th December, 2009 the government issued the Circular Ref. No. OP/CAB.9/1A on Implementation of the New Government Transport policy in State Corporations. A copy of the Circular is attached.

All State corporations were required to replace official saloon cars of Chief Executive Officers which exceeded the approved 1800cc engine capacity rating and replace them with complaint ones whose cost should not exceed KShs.4 million (Four Million). The Corporations were also required to adjust reimbursement of travel costs for Board members who use personal vehicles to attend official business to AA rates applicable to use of saloon cars with engine capacity not exceeding 1800cc. This was to take effect from 1st February, 2010.

SCAC has been tasked to monitor implementation of the New Transport Policy in State Corporations and submit a report to the Government.

In this connection please submit to us the registration, make and engine rating of the official cars of CEOs of State Corporations under your ministry. Where a State Corporation has not been able to replace the non-compliant car the CEO should agree on a time frame with SCAC by 30th April 2010.

Please also submit data of the Corporations' expenditure on reimbursement of Board members travel costs before and after implementation of the Circular requirements.

The information should be submitted in the attached format. State Corporations that fail to submit the information will be deemed not to have complied with the policy.
