MUNERATION OF COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY, JUDICIAL TRIBUNALS, ARDS AND COMMITTEES APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNMENT

As you are aware, the Government has not had a structured remuneration system for amissions of Inquiry, Judicial Tribunals, Boards and Committees appointed from time to time to look into matters of National interest as outlined in their Terms of Reference.

In order to address this situation, it has been decided that a harmonized remuneration system in terms of daily rates of allowances to be paid to Commissioners/Members and various categories of staff attached to Commissions of Inquiry, Judicial Tribunals, Boards and Committees established by Government be implemented with effect from 1st July, 2005 at the following rates:-

Allowances being Reimbursement of Expenses for Commissions of Inquiry, Judicial Tribunals, Boards and Committees appointed by the Government.
